





S-AF2 ANGLED IMPALING CLIPS

BACK OF PANEL



CROSS SECTION



APPLICATION:

For mounting fiberglass acoustical wall panels.

DESCRIPTION:

This installation technique uses **Angled-Impaling Clips** to mount fiberglass acoustical wall panels.

Installation is completed in the following order:

- 1. Lay out panel location on the wall.
- 2. Fasten **S-AF2 Impaling Clips** to the wall 48" 0.C. with the points facing up.

NOTE: If panel dimension is less than 48", space clips evenly.

- 3. Attach panels by pressing down toward the wall so points imbed firmly in the back of the panel.
- 4. This installation technique will leave a 1.25" reveal between the ceiling and the top of the panel.
- 5. Use the following guide to determine the number of **S-AF2-Impaling Clips** to be used per panel:

PANEL SIZE	NUMBER OF CLIPS
Up to 8ft²	2
9ft² to 16ft²	4
17ft² to 32ft²	6
33ft² to 60ft²	8

Horizontal panels greater than 4' wide and less than 8ft² use 3 clips...

NOTE: Due to variations in fiberglass thickness and wall inconsistencies, some shimming may be required to align the panel edges.
